Notice of Public Meeting

A decision served in this proceeding on July 15, 2004, determined that a public meeting will be held to permit interested persons to express their views about the application filed by Wisconsin Central Ltd. for permission to abandon a line of railroad, known as the Plymouth Line, extending from milepost 114.8 near Saukville to milepost 151.8 near Kiel, a distance of approximately 37 miles in Ozaukee, Sheboygan and Manitowoc Counties, WI.

The public meeting will be held in the theater of the Random Lake High School, located at 605 Random Lake Road, Random Lake, WI, on August 13, 2004, at 9:00 a.m. The meeting will continue until everyone has had the opportunity to speak. Persons wishing to speak at the meeting should place their names on the list of speakers upon their arrival at the high school.
