INVESTIGATION AND SUSPENSION DOCKET NO. 35004

PROTEST OF NCC ACTION TAKEN MAY 3, 1999
(National Motor Freight Classification)

Decided: August 26, 1999

By decision served July 16, 1999, the Board instituted an investigation in this proceeding and suspended operation of certain tariff schedules.¹ A procedural schedule for the submission of evidence is set forth below.

It is ordered:

1. Opening statements of facts and arguments by Respondent and any supporting parties are due on September 29, 1999.
2. Statements of facts and arguments by Protestant and any supporting parties are due on October 29, 1999.
3. Replies by Respondent and any supporting parties are due on November 18, 1999.
4. This decision is effective on the service date.
