By decision served on April 6, 2005, the Surface Transportation Board announced that it will hold an oral argument in these proceedings on Wednesday, May 11, 2005, at 10:00 a.m., in Room 760, the Board's Hearing Room, on the 7th floor at the Board's headquarters in the Mercury Building, 1925 K Street, N.W., Washington, DC. The parties, Kaneb Pipe Line Partners, L.P., and Kaneb Pipe Line Operating Partnership, L.P. (collectively, Kaneb), Dyno Nobel Inc. (Dyno), and CF Industries, Inc. (CFI), have provided the names of their speakers. The following speakers are scheduled to address the Board: for Kaneb, Albert S. Tabor, Jr.; for CFI, Mitchell F. Hertz; and for Dyno, Donald G. Avery.

The three parties will each have 20 minutes of argument time. Kaneb will open, followed by CFI and then Dyno. The speakers should be prepared to answer questions from the bench.

As indicated in the April 6 decision scheduling the oral argument, if a party wishes to enhance its argument by using projector-adaptable visual displays and/or handouts, it may do so. Staff will be available to demonstrate the Hearing Room's projection system on May 10, 2005, from 2 p.m. to 4 p.m. Please call (202) 565-1664 to make arrangements.
