Dear Ms. Rutson:

Although you are not soliciting public comment at this time, I feel it is important that you know the above referenced request will serve a project that has encountered serious obstacles and fierce opposition. I believe any further study of this request is premature and wasteful of taxpayer funded resources. Consider the following:

- The application for the landfill this rail line would serve has been suspended since October 2006.
- The application for the quarry was deemed deficient in May 2007.
- There is no formal application submitted for a biofuels plant.
- There are four federal agencies on record that have identified environmental issues of concern regarding the project that would be served by this rail line.

If you continue to proceed with this RJ Corman request, it is imperative a full environmental impact statement be prepared in order to assess the environmental impact of this proposal and the project it will serve.

I am opposed to the reconstruction of the above rail line. The railroad would have no purpose other than to support the operation of the Rush Township Landfill. The proposed landfill has met strong opposition from neighboring municipalities for the past five years. There are many environmental issues related to the health and welfare of the residents along the rail route.

This rail line and landfill are also located in the gateway to the Pa Wilds area which is an avid tourist attraction.
