Dear Ms. Johnson-Ball:

I'm writing to object to establishing a waste transfer station on the Olin Chemical Co. site in Wilmington, Massachusetts.

We in Wilmington have been seriously impacted by industrial pollution and already leachate from this very site has caused our town to close contaminated wells.

This transfer station will add more contamination close to a densely occupied residential area, two elementary schools, a day care center and a large senior housing complex. The excessive heavy truck traffic will seriously impact the tranquility of the residential area and endanger the lives of men, women and children living there.

We do not need a "Love Canal" situation in Wilmington.

I request that the Surface Transportation Board reject the creation of the transfer station in Wilmington.
