I have been a resident in North Woburn for 10 years. I am appalled at the proposed "trash transfer station" that may be put on Eames Street in Wilmington.

The reasons for opposition are listed below;

- Route 38 in Woburn is a heavily populated residential area that cannot stand additional traffic never mind an estimated 400 trucks coming and going from this site. Route 38 is not equipped to handle the additional traffic.
- There are two elementary schools and I am concerned for the children's safety with the additional traffic and large trucks.
- The smell of the trash being dumped onto this site will affect every neighborhood within miles of the site. Also the noise as a result of the operation will affect every neighborhood in the vicinity of the site.

This proposal is a threat to our nice, residential North Woburn community. I am asking that you carefully assess all of my concerns listed above and think about how it will affect not only North Woburn, but also the entire city of Woburn!
