Dear Secretary Williams:

Please accept this letter as a notice that my client, the Northern Indiana Commuter Transportation District (hereafter "NICTD"), intends to participate in the above referenced proceeding as a Party of Record. As attorney for NICTD, I request to be added to the service list and receive copies of all motions, pleadings, correspondence and any other filings made in connection with the above referenced proceeding. As a matter of information, NICTD owns and operates what is commonly known as the South Shore Railroad, a commuter railroad running from South Bend, Indiana to Randolph Street in Chicago, Illinois. At the present time we are aware of two significant issues that the above-referenced matter raises that might impact on NICTD.

The first issue is that the proposed acquisition could significantly impact commuter railroad operations at the 115th Street, Chicago, Illinois joint facility. NICTD has engineering plans to make improvements at the interlocking plant, which would improve the efficiency of commuter trains transverseing this area. We need to evaluate how this transaction might impact this critical interlocking plant. Approximately fourteen thousand daily commuters cross this joint facility on their journey to work, special events or home. Any adverse effects arising from this proposed transaction could separate Northwest Indiana commuters from the Chicago metropolitan area. The consequential environmental issues would be devastating to the Metro region.

The second issue is that the Canadian National Railway Company owns property in Indiana that may be used for joint passenger and freight operations. The proposed acquisition might, likewise, cause an effect on this traffic.


