I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for the meeting you were able to arrange on behalf of R.J. Corman Railroad Company/Pennsylvania Lines and Resource Recovery, LLC at the STB offices on December 14, 2007. The meeting was very informative and we appreciate the guidance and information provided by your staff and the Office of Proceedings.

In accordance with our discussions, R.J. Corman Railroad Company/Pennsylvania Lines ("RJCP") submits this letter as notice pursuant to 49 C.F.R. §1105.10(a)(1) that it intends to file either an Application or a Notice of Exemption with respect to the construction of the Rush Township Industrial Track, a reactivation of approximately 20 miles of former Conrail lines generally east of Wallaceton, Pennsylvania.

RJCP, together with Resource Recovery, Inc., the developer of the Rush Township Industrial Park, have engaged the firm of Skelly and Loy in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania to perform an Environmental Report for this project.

We would like to arrange to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding as to the scope and nature of this report and suggest that a meeting in early January would be appropriate. If you concur, could you please advise of your availability?

We anticipate filing an Application or Notice of Exemption in late January, 2008. In view of your staff's familiarity with this project after the meeting in your office, the limited impact likely to result from reactivating an existing, intact roadbed, and the retention of experienced environmental consultants, RJCP respectfully requests, pursuant to §1105.10(c), a partial waiver of the six-month Prefiling Notice requirement.

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We appreciate your consideration of this request and thank you again for the opportunity to meet with your staff and the representative from the Office of Proceedings.
