Dear Mr. Navecky:

The staff of the Office of Ocean and Coastal Resource Management (OCRM) certifies that the above referenced project is consistent with the S.C. Coastal Zone Management Program provided that (1) no freshwater wetlands are disturbed or altered and that (2) all necessary erosion and sediment control practices are maintained until the entire site is stabilized. **If the activity includes land disturbing of 2 acres or greater or if less than two acres but within one-half mile of a receiving water body, a stormwater permit application must be submitted and approved by OCRM prior to any land disturbing activity. If land disturbing activities will be 2 acres or less and not within one-half mile of a receiving water body then a submittal using the "disturbing less than 2 acre" form is required.**

This certification shall serve as the **final approval for the referenced permit only**, by OCRM.

Interested parties are provided thirty days from receipt of this letter to appeal the action of OCRM.
