Surveyed – September 7, 1883

Mounds on the Cottonwood River near New Ulm: E ½, SE ¼, Section 33 and S ½, SW ¼, Section 34, T110-30 along bluffs of the Cottonwood River. Twenty-seven (27) mounds scattered loosely along the north side of the river of which only three (3) are elongated. Several are large in size: visual 70foot by 4 ½ feet by 6 feet, by 3 ½ feet by 80 feet and 70 feet by 3 ½ feet.

Final note of survey Section 33 – Section 34:

There are probably numerous other mounds in these counties of which there is no information.

The descriptions of the mounds are similar to what Ben and I seen in Section 34. This is the only mention of Section 34, the rest are for the area in Section 33.
