Dear Mr. Blodgett,

I have been following the proceedings on the abandonment of the lower end of the Middletown and New Jersey Railway. I am a former employee of the railroad and former Town Historian and would like to make the following comments. The railroad has already been abandoned and virtually all scrap metal was removed by the end of 2007.

The attached photo taken near the end of the scrapping was taken in December of 2007. I have also noted that the Coast and Geodetic Survey people are concerned about the preservation of markers. I do not know what markers they are referring to but believe that the markers may be the concrete mileposts that used to stand along the right of way. The scrappers removed most of the mileposts last summer and gave them to interested parties. Several of the posts are shown in the attached photo stacked in a yard.

The railroad was essentially completely scrapped before any paperwork was filed with the STB.


