I am against the proposed Transrail facility at the Olin Chemical Site in Wilmington MA.


Two heavily populated sections of Wilmington and Woburn will suffer from The grinding process noise as well as the odor and pests from the municipal solid waste which will be handled at the site.

Residential neighborhoods in Woburn and Wilmington will suffer with the additional 400 trucks a day transporting hazardous waste through their backyards and 2 elementary schools, a daycare center and senior housing complex located in North Woburn on or near the route used by the trucks.

The extent of contamination of the Olin site is not yet fully understood. The Olin site should remain undeveloped until it's contamination issues are better understood and/or resolved.

Please don't let Transrail take away the quality of life for the families living in Wilmington and Woburn.
