Dear Mr. Cain:

As you know, the Surface Transportation Board's (Board) Section of Environmental Analysis (SEA) is conducting an environmental review process for the above abandonment proceeding pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act and the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA). SEA has been consulting with the Wisconsin Historical Society (SHPO) and Wisconsin Central Ltd. (the Applicant) regarding this proceeding and has determined that the proposed abandonment will have an adverse effect on the National Register of Historic Places (National Register) eligible Ashland Ore Dock.

SEA has identified your agency as having a potential interest in this undertaking. SEA has also identified the Wisconsin Board of Commissioners of Public Lands, City of Ashland, and 21 additional Federally Recognized Tribes as potential consulting parties pursuant to the Section 106 regulations of NHPA. SEA intends to work with the consulting parties throughout the Section 106 process including the development of a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) to stipulate the resolution of adverse effects to identified National Register eligible historic properties. Please inform us if you would like to participate in the Section 106 process as a consulting party for this proceeding.

The following documents are enclosed for your review pursuant to 36 CFR 800.11(e):

- Applicant's environmental and historic reports;
- The Environmental Assessment prepared by SEA;
- The Board's decision dated April 28, 2006; and
- The Applicant's Status Report dated October 24, 2006.
