This is to advise that as of November 1, 2008, the Union Pacific Railroad Company, ("UP") with regard to the subject Abandonment Exemption has consummated the abandonment of the Tyler Industrial Lead between Milepost 0.25 near Troup to Milepost 7.50 near Whitehouse, Texas, pursuant to authority granted in the Surface Transportation Board's ("Board") Decisions served May 11, 2006, June 7, 2006 and the consummation extensions granted to date, the most recent having a service date of May 5, 2008. In that decision, the Board granted an extension to November 1, 2008. This filing is made on November 3, 2008, the first business day following November 1, 2008.

All conditions imposed by the Board for abandonment of the Line have been satisfied and salvage activities have been completed.
